NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit- Pacific Beach Half Marathon & 5K **COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Mission Bay, Pacific Beach and Mission Beach

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 2

LOCATION: City streets in Pacific Beach, De Anza Cove (see attached maps)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for the Pacific Beach Half Marathon & 5K run that would take place along various city streets within the Mission Bay, Pacific Beach and Mission Beach areas and within De Anza Cove (see attached maps) on October 7, 2023. The event would include run routes, a stage, performances, sound amplification, generators, fencing and/or barriers, tables and chairs, prepackaged food, non-alcoholic beverages, portable restrooms and recycled and trash containers. The number of total attendees is estimated at 4000. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from October 6, 2023 at 8 AM to October 7, 2023 at 1 PM. Set-up would occur on over two days; October 6, 2023 from 8 AM to 7 PM and on October 7, 2023 from 4 AM to 6 AM, the event would occur on October 7, 2023 from 6 AM to 11:30 AM and dismantling would follow from 11"30 AM to 1 PM.

Road closures, times and dates associated with the event would occur along the roads as shown on attached list of Road Closures.

The following parking lots would also be closed on October 7, 2023:

- from 4 AM to 8 AM; De Anza Cove (west side lot),
- from 4 AM to 9:30 AM; Ventura Cover Parking Lot (approximately 93 spaces),
- from 5 AM to 9:30 AM; Sunset Point Park (approximately 22 spaces),
- from 4 AM to 10 AM; South Jetty Parking lot (approximately 65 spaces)

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego

conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.







