NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit – Mission Bay Triathlon **COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Mission Bay Park, Mission Beach

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 2

LOCATION: Bonita Cove, Ventura Cove, Mission Beach, and surrounding roadways (see attached

maps)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a triathlon/duathlon race event that would occur on October 15, 2023 at various locations in Bonita Cove, Ventura Cove, and surrounding roadways (see attached maps) within Mission Bay and Mission Beach. The event would include the swimming, bicycling, and running events, portable restrooms, canopies, tables, chairs, a stage, generators, sound amplification, a fenced-in beer garden, and entertainment. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 7 AM on October 14, 2023, until 2 PM on October 15, 2023. Set-up would occur on October 14, 2023 from 7 AM to 5 PM, the event would occur on October 15, 2023 from 6 AM to 12:30 PM and dismantling would occur on October 15, 2023 from 12:30 PM to21 PM.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing

commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
