Wines and Liquors, to its patrons
at all hours of Day and night, in
violation of the City ordinance;

Although this is well known,
no action has been taken to
compel the payment of the City
License of Twenty five Dollars per
month as provided for by the
Ordinance, for Restaurants,
Hotels, and Eating Houses, selling
Liquors.

The owners of said Restaurant
admit that they do sell the
same by having procured a
United States Revenue License,
but are paying no attention
whatever to the City License

while all Hotels selling
under similar Conditions
are paying it -

We respectfully
request an investigation of
the matter herein set forth.
