Gentlemen:-

At a regular meeting of the Board held this day The Secretary was directed to address a communication to the Common Council recommending that ordinance #924 adopted June 4th, 1901, be repealed; and that an ordinance be passed allowing \$108.00 per year commencing July 1st, 1901, for the keeping in good condition the street or road lying between the Pacific Beach Race Track and Sorento Station. The said ordinance #924, as adopted, is for but a term of six months duration and terminates just at the time when it is the most needed, viz:—December 31st. 1901.
