

TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF SAN DIEGO.

Gentlemen:-

We the undersigned members of San Diego Mothers Club, respectfully petition your honorable body to grant no saloon licenses on K st. east of 7th., for the following reasons:

First, It is the declared policy of your body to keep the residence sections of the city free from saloons and the sale of intoxicating liquors.

Second, The Federated Clubs, with which we are connected, are maintaining the K st. park, simply for the good of the city and especially the section in which it is located, and where it is so much needed. The two saloons now in the immediate vicinity menace our work by causing unpleasant scenes, and a feeling of insecurity that prevents women and children from coming again.

Third, Said saloons being distant from the center of the city are less under police control than others, which fact increases the feeling of insecurity on the part of visitors to the park, and those in charge.
