- The CRB recommends to SDPD that the Canine Unit continue to investigate and evaluate complaints regarding canine deployments and forward their reports to Internal Affairs. When there is a canine-related Use of Force (Category 1) complaint, IA will submit a report to the CRB for review. When such a case is on the CRB agenda, someone from the Canine Unit will be invited to the meeting to be available to answer questions. It is further recommended that the CRB receive additional training on evaluating canine-related complaints.

- The CRB recommends the following changes to SDPD's Axon Body Worn Cameras Procedures, Section V. I, (Mandated Recordings), 1. (Enforcement Related Contacts):
 1. Officers shall use the Event Mode to record enforcement related contacts. The Event Mode ~~should~~ must be activated prior to actual contact with the citizen, or as soon as practical and safely possible thereafter, and continue recording until the contact is concluded or the contact transitions from an enforcement contact into intelligence gathering.
 2. Officers ~~should~~ must begin recording in the Event Mode while driving to a call that has the potential to involve an enforcement contract, provided it is safe and practical to do so.
