

# MISSION BAY PARK SPECIAL EVENT NARRATIVE AND IMPACT

## 2016 Three Wise Men Foundation Memorial Bike Ride Fundraiser

### 1. Type of Event:

*The Three Wise Men (3WM) Foundation, in conjunction with the Tour of California, is holding a fundraising bike ride on May 14. 3WM Foundation is a non-profit organization that helps veterans who survived combat survive the peace that follows through advocacy, education and employment. This charity bike ride takes place on the day before the Tour of California and is being held with the support of the Tour of California San Diego Local Organizing Committee. It will depart in waves from Ski Beach (the start of the Tour of California) at 8am and finish at Marina Village as riders complete the course.*

*We are asking to use Ski Beach from approximately 7:30 until 8:30 when the last riders should leave. Parking will be on the street at Quivira Road. Registration will be in the Marina Village Parking lot (SCPT Marina Village, LLC has donated 16 parking spots for registration tents/tables only). The finish will be on Quivira Road.*

*It is important to note, after leaving Ski Beach the ride will not intentionally impact Mission Bay Parks other than the increased cycling traffic for the start and finish.*

### 2. When, Day and Date:

- a. Date- Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup>
- b. Time- The ride will start at Ski Beach Park in Mission Bay at 8am in waves of approximately 50 riders per wave.
- c. We will have two courses.
  - 109-mile option will follow the Tour of California route and will not impact Mission Bay Parks. Time to complete will be in the 4-7 hour range depending on the individual rider
  - 30-mile option moves through Ocean Beach/Pt Loma to turnaround at the entrance to the Cabrillo Monument, around San Diego Bay to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, north to University Ave to Washington Ave to San Diego Ave through Old Town to Pacific Highway to Sea World Drive to Old Sea World Drive to Quivira Road. Time to complete will be in the 2-hour range.
  - Both rides will follow rules of the road and have been approved by SDPD Special Events.
