To the Honorable Board of City Council of the City  
of San Diego, California,

Your petitioners would respectfully ask the use  
of the following described lands in the City Park,  
for the purposes of experimenting in growing trees  
and flowers, under the same terms, and restrictions,  
for ten years, as was granted to Miss K.O. Sepions  
by your board recently. Commencing at the south line  
of the Park and east side of the Boulevard, thence east  
six hundred feet, thence northerly twenty nine hundred  
feet, thence west to east side of Boulevard. six hundred  
feet, thence south along east line of said Boulevard  
twenty nine hundred feet to place of beginning. Our  
object is the introduction of useful and ornamental trees  
and plants having been experimenting on such things  
for nineteen years here.

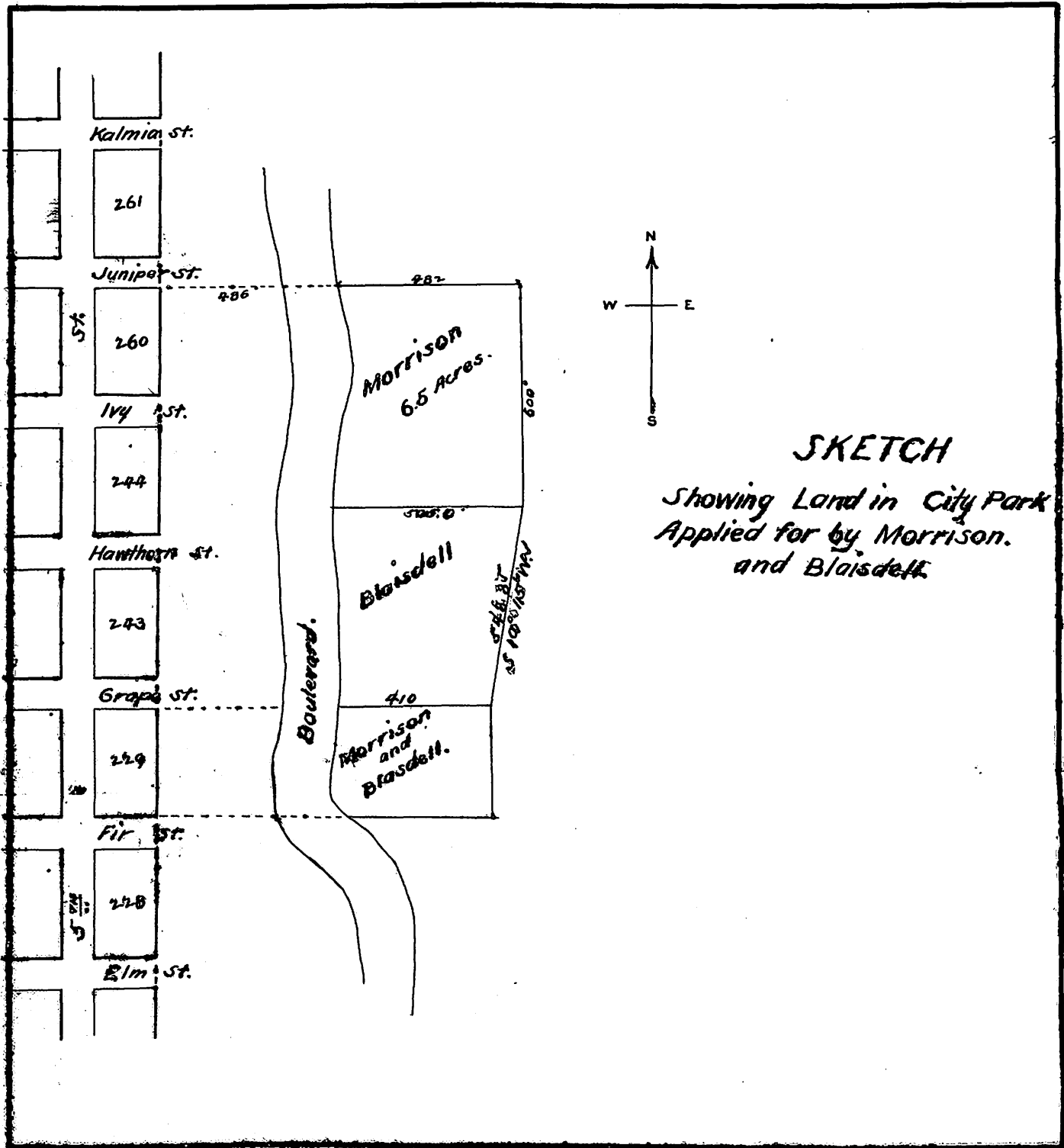
