San Diego, Cal., January 23, 1917.

To the Honorable,
Judge of the Superior Court of the
County of San Diego, State of California,
Department 2.

We, the Grand Jury called and empanelled by your Honor,
October 17th, 1916, with George Walters as foreman, hereby made
this partial report.

For the purpose of placing the matter referred to in the reso-
lution hereinafter set forth before the Board of Supervisors of
San Diego County, and the Common Council of the City of San Diego,
and after being convinced of the necessity therefor, the Grand
Jury did on the 16th day of January, 1916, unanimously adopt the
following resolution, a copy of which will be furnished to said
Board of Supervisors of San Diego County and the Common Council of
the City of San Diego:

"Be it resolved by the Grand Jury of San Diego County that we
urge the Board of Supervisors of San Diego County, the city of San
Diego and all municipalities to immediately enact an anti-race
track ordinance to prevent the publication of form charts and
advertisements of the various races and their being circulated
anywhere within the county of San Diego no matter where the races
are run. We would recommend that if necessary the initiative be
used to get these ordinances enacted.

A suggestive form of ordinance is here appended."
