Councilman Kersey Appointed to the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Board

San Diego (May 17, 2016) – San Diego City Councilman Mark Kersey was appointed today to the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority Board at the recommendation of Mayor Kevin Faulconer. His appointment was unanimously confirmed by the San Diego City Council.

The San Diego County Regional Airport Authority manages the day-to-day operations of the San Diego International Airport and address the region's long-term air transportation needs.

"As a respected leader on the City Council and Chair of the City's Infrastructure Committee, Councilmember Kersey understands the critical role the airport plays in our success as a region," Mayor Faulconer said.

In addition to serving on the Airport Authority, Kersey is on the Board of Directors for the San Diego Regional Economic Development Council and serves as the City's representative to the California League of Cities.

"I look forward to serving as the City's representative to the Airport Authority so we can ensure our transportation network meets the needs of San Diego's growing population and binational high-tech economy," Kersey said.

Kersey will serve a three-year term through 2019.
