Debt refinancing to save San Diego \$300M

New budget additions invest heavily in public safety

Earlier this spring the Mayor released his <u>proposed fiscal year</u> <u>2017 budget</u>. In May, he announced revisions to the budget due to increased revenue projections. The budget revision includes more funding for the Police Department, including an additional \$4.7 million to address recruitment and retention issues for police officers and 911 dispatchers.
