

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND
SAN DIEGO RIVER PARK FOUNDATION FOR SAN DIEGO RIVER CLEAN-UP
COORDINATIONS**

This First Amendment to the Contract between the City of San Diego and San Diego River Park Foundation for assessments of the San Diego River and clean-up events in the San Diego River. (First Amendment) is made and entered into by and between the City of San Diego (City) and San Diego River Park Foundation (Contractor), also referred to individually as “Party” and collectively as the “Parties.”

RECITALS

1. City issued a non-profit contract under SDMC section 22.3210, resulting in a contract between the City and Contractor (Contract). The Contract is comprised of: the Contract and all exhibits, including Exhibit A (Scope of Services), the City’s General Contract Terms and Provisions, and city required forms. The Contract provides for the following: (1) Identify and quantify trash, debris, and dumping in the San Diego Riverbed and organize events to remove the waste; and (2) SDRPF staff will share data with Department staff to coordinate and maximize waste removal efforts, as further described in the Scope of Services (Services) attached to the Contract as Exhibit A.

2. The Contract may be amended by written agreement executed by duly authorized representatives of both Parties.

3. The Parties wish to amend the Contract to: (1) Raise the not to exceed amount to allow funding for future renewals.

TERMS

1. Article III, Compensation

2. Section 3.1 of the Contract is revised in part to read as follows:

Amount of Compensation. City shall pay Contractor for performance of all Services rendered in accordance with this Contract in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

3. This First Amendment will be effective when signed by both parties and approved by the City Attorney in accordance with Charter section 40.

4. All provisions of the Contract not addressed in this First Amendment remain in full force and effect.
