

AN ORDINANCE PROCLAIMING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING A CERTAIN ORDINANCE TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$5000.00 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of January, 1920, the Common Council of The City of San Diego passed an ordinance, numbered 7929, and entitled, "An Ordinance prohibiting publication and distribution of information concerning horse races and betting thereon," which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor of said City on January 23rd, 1920; and

WHEREAS, within thirty days from the date of its final passage and its approval by the Mayor of said City, a petition signed by the electors of said City equal in number to at least seven per cent. of the entire vote cast for all candidates for mayor at the last preceding general election at which a mayor was elected, was filed with the Clerk of said City, which said petition protested against the passage of such ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said Common Council reconsidered such ordinance and failed and refused to repeal the same, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority vested in the Common Council of The City of San Diego, California, by Section 3, Chapter IV, Article I of the City Charter;

PROCLAMATION IS HEREBY MADE that on Tuesday, the 7th day of December, 1920, a Special Election will be held in The City of San Diego, California, for the purpose of submitting to the vote of the electors of The City of San Diego that certain ordinance passed by the Common Council of said City on the 21st day of January, 1920, and approved by the Mayor on the 23rd day of January, 1920, and
