On March 16, 2018, Development Services Department **APPROVED** an application for Substantial Conformance Review (SCR), Process Two, under the Master Storm Water System Maintenance Program (MSWMP), Amended Site Development Permit (SDP) No. 2034245 and PEIR 42891/SCH 2004101032, for maintenance to remove sediment, vegetation, trash and debris using mechanized equipment. The property is located between Britannia Boulevard and Otay Pacific Road (MMP Maps 126 and 127), within the Otay Mesa Planning area.
