On August 27, 2018, Development Services Department APPROVED an application for Substantial Conformance Review (Process Two) under the Master Storm Water System Maintenance Program (MMP), Amended Site Development Permit (SDP) No. 2034245 and PEIR 42891/SCH 2004101032, for After the fact-SCR for Emergency Maintenance performed in November 2015 for the removal of dense vegetation and sediment in a 650 foot long, 6 foot wide, concrete lined drainage channel located south of SR 905, north of Via de la Bandola, east of Picador Boulevard.
