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On August 13, 2018, Development Services Department APPROVED an application for Substantial Conformance Review (Process Two) under the Master Storm Water System Maintenance Program (MMP), Amended Site Development Permit (SDP) No. 2034245 and PEIR 42891/SCH 2004101032, for previous emergency work conducted in November & December of 2014 to remove vegetation and sediment blocking drainage channels in San Carlos Creek. The Maintenance area was in three different section of the concrete-lined storm water channel. The first, the Beaver Lake section located south of Beaver Lake Drive between Cowles Mountain Boulevard and Boulder Lake Avenue. The second, the Golf Course section, west of Cowles Mountain Boulevard and adjacent to the Mission Trails Golf Course. The third area is the Lake Badin Section which is east of Lake Badin Avenue.

This project is within the scope of Program Environmental Impact Report No. 42891/State Clearing House 2004101032, Certified on October 2011. This Program Environmental Impact Report adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA.
