Subject: Webinar on Online Permitting Enhancements for Residential Solar

Photovoltaic

The Development Services Department (DSD) will host a webinar on Wednesday, Aug. 2 at 11 a.m. to help customers apply for residential solar photovoltaic permits and battery storage projects.

The webinar will explain planned upgrades to online permitting per Senate Bill 379 and include a live demonstration on applying for a permit. These upgrades will make applying for a solar PV permit and battery-storage projects up to 38.4 kw for single-dwelling units and duplexes faster and easier.

Starting Aug. 7, customers will be able to submit new residential solar photovoltaic (PV) and battery storge applications, upload plans and specifications and receive a permit in real time through DSD's online permitting portal.

The interactive Zoom webinar will be facilitated by senior DSD staff and recorded for viewing online 24/7.
