
To The Honorable Common Council,

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

LaJolla Beach and Yacht Club of LaJolla, California, has made application for a permit for the construction at LaJolla of two reinforced concrete breakwaters, 800 and 1000 feet in length projecting into the ocean to enclose a harbor measuring about 600 feet by 600 feet and with a 200-foot entrance to sea.

The LaJolla Beach and Yacht Club also applies for authority to dredge a channel through the entrance above referred to and across the harbor to give access to a lagoon on the Club's property. The channel is to have a bottom width of 120 feet and a depth ranging from 16 to 14 feet below mean lower low water. The dredgings are to be dumped on the properties of the LaJolla Shores and LaJolla Beach and Yacht Club.

Drawings showing location of the proposed breakwater and dredging projects will be on exhibition in this office until 11 A. M., Wednesday, October 6, 1926.

Interested persons are invited to inspect these drawings and to submit in writing, in triplicate, on or before that date, any objections based on navigation interests which they may have to the proposed work. Objections based on other than navigation interests cannot be considered.
