GENTLEMEN:

Documents Nos. 308811, 309182 and 313186, concerning the granting of a Dine and Dance license to Josie Sciuto, are returned with the information there seems to be more protestants in the neighborhood against granting the petition than there are petitioners seeking it.

The protestants feel that a dine and dance hall in their community would bring increased disturbance to the district in which they have their homes and families. It is further felt it would not be fair to grant the renter of property a privilege which would be objectionable to persons owning their own places.

Inasmuch as the business of operating a dine and dance hall is such that it requires a license to operate, and the further fact that the property owners object to the license being granted, it would appear that their wishes should carry the preponderance of weight over that of the petitioners for the granting of the license.

It is, therefore, my recommendation that the petition be denied.
