I hereby petition for permission to construct a six inch sewer on Loy Lane from Sixth St to Fifth St, in accordance with city ordinances directing such work so that it may be accepted as part of the regular sewerage system of the city.

The house being built which this sewer will at once accommodate is situated on lots 9 & 10 Blk 2 - Crittenden's Addition and is the property of Mrs. Ellen Sessions of San Francisco.

The special topography of this locality makes this sewer along Loy Lane a ^{practical} drain for the lots along Sixth Street for several hundred feet - and I trust the Special Committee of your body will consider its location and practicability at an early date.
