Thank you for your good staff work and support over the last months.

I have been reviewing, in detail, the base map of the Council Districts, on your web site.

I have noticed that in my Home Communities – Zip Codes 92105 and 92102; City Heights/Southeast that a mis identifier appears on the base map . The mis identifier is an artifact from nearly a century ago; was very short lived; and was democratically removed by a vote of both the residents and the City of San Diego

As you are aware, the original boundary of the City of San Diego, as laid out in the Fitch Map and later surveys, is a diagonal line from North of La Jolla bay to the intersection of the navigable middle of San Diego Bay. The North South Line appears on maps as “Boundary Street” [West of the I-805 at University Avenue near North Park or East of the SR 15 Freeway at Market Street by Mt. Hope Cemetery ] All lands East of Boundary Street were once East San Diego County.

In the 1880’s a major East San Diego County subdivision was developed, along Boundary Street- CITY HEIGHTS. That subdivision is portrayed below:
