Dear Sir:

Your letter of December 12th to the City Council of the City of San Diego has been referred to this office.

In the appropriation ordinance for 1940-41 the sum of \$3500 was set up for the construction of a fire station at Roseville. This appropriation was made in the expectation that such station might be erected as a W.P.A. Project and the sum included in the appropriation represented only the sponsor's contribution to such a project. The sum of \$3500 of course is quite inadequate for the construction of a station of the character required.

The Harbor Department has provided no funds, so I am advised, for the erection of a fire station in the Point Loma district and the Director of the Harbor Department has further advised me that he will not recommend that Harbor Department funds be diverted to this purpose.

This office has on several occasions indicated that the construction of a fire station in Roseville will be considered in the preparation of the budget for the ensuing fiscal year.
