To The Honorable The Mayor,
and Common Council.

Gentlemen,

Petitioner has been conducting dances at the Germania Hall for Period of over two years, He has never had a lease on the place, nor to my knowlege hasr he ever applied for one, the only reason he gave me for asking for permit to pay it quarterly was because he didnot have the money to pay for one for the year.

So far all of the rest of the persons who are operating dance halls, have paid for 12 months in advance, with the exception of chas O Bosworth, who operates Hank & Ham's old time dace hall on 58th stree and ElCajon ave. His report was that he had been operating with a lease, and that he had applied for a renewal of same, but had been given no assurance that it would be renewed. that if it was renewed, he would at the end of the three month period, pay the remainder of the year all at one time.

The conditions surrounding the attached petition are much different, in as-much as there never has been a lease in existance at the germania Hall, further more they do not give leases on the hall, Mr Perry has been paying his rent by the night, and the person to whom his rent is paid informs me that as far as He is concerned Mr Perry can have the hall for as long as he pays rent, that his dances has been conducted in a respectfull manner, and the fact that his dances were not conducted in such a manner would be the only reason for not renting him the hall,

The recommendation of the License inspector is that the petition be denied, for the reason that this office has exacted a year in advance from others.


