Gentlemen,

Petitioner has been running a dance hall at the Woodbine Hall, 848 5th ave, since the first of July, a party by the name of Joe Hernandez, was granted a permit by your Honorable Body to conduct dances at this place, but he didnot continue, and Mr Page thought the license had been taken care of by Hernandez.

Mr Page says he does not know how long he and his orchestra will be able to hold out, that the dances are only being held on Sunday Nites, and are not being held with the object of making money out of it, that some of the orchestra are out of employment and that what theyearn on sunday nite's helps to tide them over, that after the overhead expences are paid what is then left is devided equally between members of the orchestra.

The recommendation of this office is that the petition be granted. a quarterly license has been granted to two other dance halls recently.
