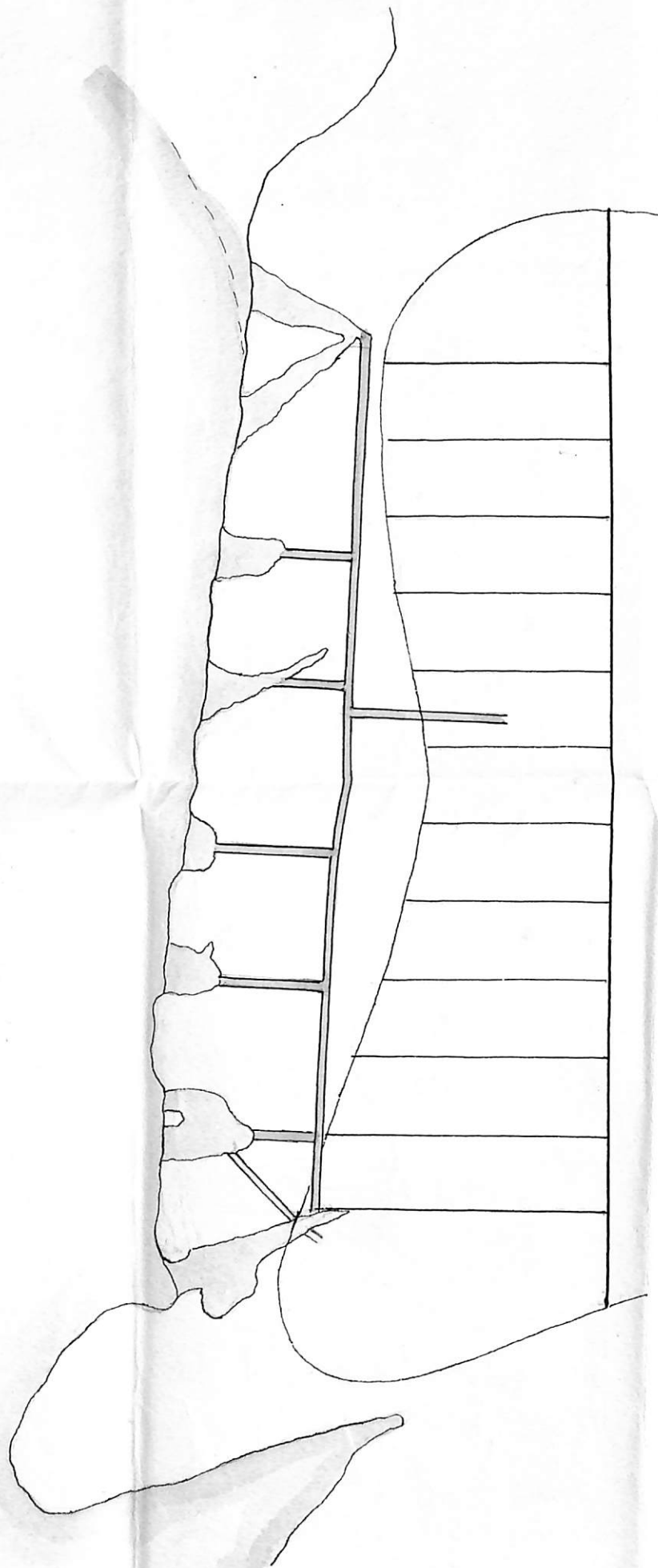


TO THE HONORABLE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CAL.

The undersigned respectfully petitions your Honorable Body, that he be permitted, and granted the right, to widen the crevice and passage way which extends from the cave opposite and adjoining lot 27 in Block 48, at La Jolla to the cave opposite Lot 25 in said Block. The distance between said caves is about sixty-five (65) feet. The passage way between said caves extends along Cave Street, but is now inaccessible. It is my desire to widen it so that tourists and sight seers can, with comfort, proceed from one cave to the other. The widening thereof can in no way affect or injure said Street.
