So we went down there and we had some drinks. My friend thought I had too much and so he told the percentage girls who were getting us to buy drinks 9 that I was only 19 years old. The girls and the two bartenders who served us didnt pay any attention until we spent all of our 10 money and my friend and I got into an argument. He tried to 11 make me leave the place but by that time I had bought so mamy irinks at the solicitation of the percentage girls that I guess I was drunk and I got mad and wouldn't leave the saloon.
