Location: 3650-3652 28th Street, 92104, Greater North Park Community, Council District 3 (1269 6-D)

<u>Description</u>: Consider the reclassification of the property located at 3650-3652 28th Street in the North Park Dryden Historic District from a Non-Contributing (6L) to a Contributing (5D1) resource and designation of the property under HRB Criterion F.

<u>Today's Action</u>: Reclassify the property as a Contributing resource and designate under HRB Criterion F, or do not reclassify and designate.

<u>Staff Recommendation</u>: Reclassify the property located at 3650-3652 28th Street in the North Park Dryden Historic District from a Non-Contributing (6L) to a Contributing (5D1) resource and designate the property under HRB Criterion F. The designation shall exclude the detached rear building addressed at 3650 28th Street, constructed in 1958 outside of the District's 1912-1941 period of significance.
