ITEM-1 VELMA PRICHARD SPEC HOUSE #1

Applicant/Owner: Teggin Family Trust 05-02-17 represented by Heritage Architecture & Planning

Consider the designation of the property located at 4321 Alder Drive, 92116, Kensington-Talmadge Community, Council District 9 as a historical resource. Report Number: HRB-23-022

PROPOSED ACTION

Designate or not designate the property as a historical resource under adopted designation criteria.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Designate the Velma Prichard Spec House #1 located at 4321 Alder Drive as a historical resource with a period of significance of 1928-1933 under HRB Criterion C. The designation excludes the two-story southeast corner addition and the storage cabinets below the south patio constructed outside of the period of significance. The designation includes the cobblestone walls of the landscaped terrace at the rear of the property as well as the four murals, painted ceiling and rafters of the breezeway.

ITEM-2 LARRY HIMMEL/DENNSTEDT COMPANY HOUSE

Consider the designation of the property located at 4609 Norma Drive, 92115, Kensignton-Talmadge Community, Council District 9 as a historical resource. Report Number: HRB-23-026

PROPOSED ACTION

Designate or not designate the property as a historical resource under adopted designation criteria.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Designate the Larry Himmel/Dennstedt Company House located at 4609 Norma Drive as a historical resource with a period of significance of 1977-1986 under HRB Criterion B and 1931 under HRB Criteria C and D. The designation includes the original detached garage and interior features including the living room stenciled open beam ceiling with decorative corbel supports, pyrographic door, staircase with wrought iron railing and decorative tiles, and sculpted plaster fireplace with quarry tile and radio niche. The designation excludes the 1985 attached utility room, the pre-1960s slump block wall stuccoed in the early 2000s, and the 2000s detached pergola structure.

ITEM-3 GREATER GOLDEN HILL HISTORIC DISTRICT CONTRIBUTOR

Applicant/Owner: Laura Petrovich represented by Legacy 106, Inc.
