The FY 2020/2021 - FY 2024/2025 San Diego Regional Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (Analysis of Impediments), presents a demographic profile of San Diego County, assesses the extent of housing needs among specific income groups, and evaluates the availability of a range of housing choices for residents. The Analysis of Impediments focuses on identifying impediments that may prevent equal housing access and developing solutions to mitigate or remove such impediments.
