This letter is in response to your application in which your firm requested the City of San Diego (City) evaluate and approve the Romac Industries, Inc. FJ Restraint Flexible Expansion Joint, XR501 Extended Range Coupling, and Style DJ400 and DJ405 Dismantling Joints.

The City has completed the review of this application and determined that adequate data has been presented to approve the Romac Industries, Inc. FJ Restraint Flexible Expansion Joint, XR501 Extended Range Coupling, and Style DJ400 and DJ405 Dismantling Joints.

The approval of these products for use on the City of San Diego's water system is effective as of the date of this letter and will be included in the next Water Approved Materials List update.

The acceptance and approval of Romac Industries, Inc. products are contingent on the following conditions:

- 1) The FJ Restraint Flexible Expansion Joint, XR501 Extended Range Coupling, and Style DJ400 and DJ405 Dismantling Joints shall have all ductile iron components manufactured at Romac Industries, Inc., located at 125 S. Sultan Basin Rd., Sultan, WA 98294 and all products assembled at the Romac Industries, Inc. plant and corporate headquarters located at 21919 20th Ave SE, Bothell, WA 98021.
- 2) Romac Industries, Inc. shall notify the City in advance of any changes in the products, ownership, or location of the manufacturing plants.


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- 3) Romac Industries, Inc. shall provide application/installation procedures for the products to ensure the products meet the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook) and the City's Whitebook 2012. The installer shall meet the specification conditions required for the proper installation of products as specified by Romac Industries, Inc. or any of Romac Industries, Inc.'s authorized suppliers.
- 4) Any unilateral action by Romac Industries, Inc. without prior consultation and agreement from the City regarding the above mentioned conditions and limitations shall constitute a breach of agreement resulting in the removal of Romac Industries, Inc. products from the City's Water Approved Materials List.
