



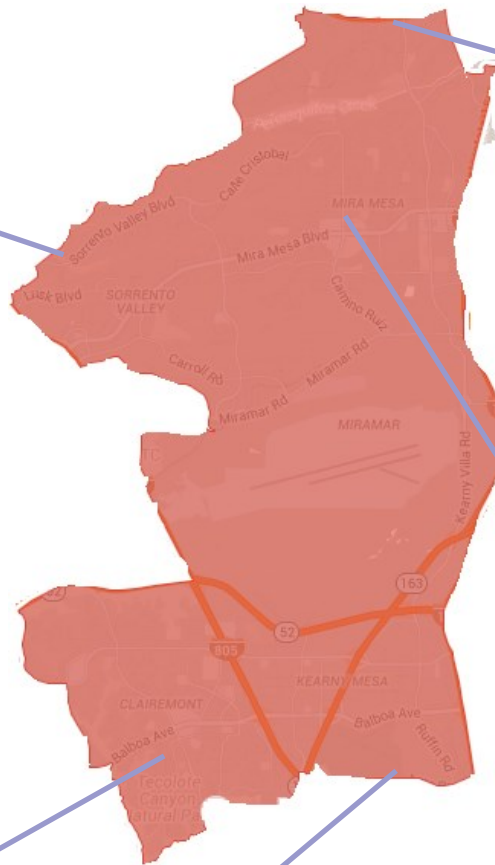
District 6 Dispatch | April 2018
