Water Safety Instructor Course

In this course you will learn the knowledge and skills necessary to become certified to teach American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety Classes. **Prerequisites: participant must be able to fulfill the following on the first day:**

- Be 16 years of age by the end of the class (Proof of age required upon registration)
- Demonstrate the ability to perform the following swimming skills using the proper technique:

Front Crawl-25 yards	Back crawl-25 yards	Breaststroke-25 yards	Elementary backstroke-25 yards
Sidestroke-25 yards	Butterfly-15 yards	Float on back 1 minute	Tread water for 1 minute
