Arrest Made in Attempted Murder in Grant Hill

San Diego – On April 5, 2022, at approximately 7:30 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a report of an assault with a deadly weapon at the basketball court at 2800 L Street. The initial information was that a male was hitting a person in a sleeping bag with a three-foot piece of wood. The suspect was described as a Black male wearing a light-colored blanket, dark "hoodie" and dark pants, with a backpack.

Patrol officers from Central Division responded and located a male lying on the basketball court covered with a blanket. He had traumatic injuries to his upper body. Medics transported the male to a local hospital where he remains in serious condition. The victim is described as a Hispanic or white male in his mid-30s who is believed to be homeless. His identity has not yet been fully confirmed. A piece of lumber that potentially matches the description of the weapon was recovered nearby on the basketball court.

At approximately 8:55 a.m., patrol officers located Rashi Foster in the area of 2400 Imperial Avenue, several blocks from the initial scene. He matched the description of the suspect. Foster is described as a 37-year-old homeless Black male.

Based on the severity of the victim's injuries, the San Diego Police Homicide Unit responded to investigate the case. Detectives are still investigating the circumstances that led up to the assault. However, based on the investigation so far, Foster was arrested and booked into jail for attempted murder.
