200 words. Comments received after the start of the meeting but before the item is called will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item.

Non-Agenda Public Comment may be submitted using the [webform](#), checking the appropriate box. Comments received by the start of the meeting will be distributed to the Appointing Authority and posted online with the meeting materials. All webform comments are limited to 200 words. Comments received after the start of the meeting but before Non-agenda comment is called will be submitted into the written record for the meeting.

Sub-Item B: Selection of Alternates for the 2020 Redistricting Commission

Proposed Actions:

Appointing Authority is to select Two (2) alternate board members for the 2020 Redistricting Commission from the pool of applicants not appointed to the Redistricting Commission within Sub-Item A of this item. In the event of a vacancy for reasons including, but not limited to, the resignation, death or incapacity of a member of the Redistricting Commission, one of the two alternate members shall fill the vacancy. Alternates shall be seated based upon the order in which they were initially appointed by the Appointing Authority.

CONTINUANCE OF ITEMS

Per San Diego Municipal Code §27.1409 the Appointing Authority may hold a second public hearing if there are additional questions or if additional time for discussion is needed prior to making the appointments. A second hearing also may be held under Municipal Code §27.1411 if the Appointing Authority determines during the hearing that there are too many candidates to consider in a single hearing, and may invite candidates to participate on a second day. At the conclusion of the second public hearing, the Appointing Authority may then, or at a later meeting, appoint the Redistricting Commission's nine members and two alternates.
