

13. Describe unique event feature not covered above? In October 2021, we were given temporary approval to hold a two-mile walk event and use the Park and President's Way Lawn to raise funds for the fight against breast cancer. We had approximately 4,000 participants. The streets were cleared of walkers by 9:15 am so as to allow access to the Park. We would like to request another temporary change for our 2022 event for the location of our tent area to the Park Blvd and President's Way Lawn. This will enable our participants to park in the Inspiration Point Parking Lot and walk across the street. They will not have to be shuttled over to our tent area on the other side of the Park. We will also use the same two-mile walk route for 2022. We anticipate the crowd to be approximately 8,000. We have received support from the Alzheimer's San Diego organization that will hold their walk on Saturday, October 15, 2022. We will work together to utilize the same vendors in order to reduce the set-up and tear down time for both events.
