BALBOA PARK ACTIVITY CENTER: Center Director Luis Ignacio reports that the Balboa Park Activity Center was closed in November/December for Homeless Shelter and Floor Resurface. The MLK breakfast in January was a success, about 700 people attended. Badminton Tournament, Rummage Sale, and Science Fair are all events coming up. Patti Riddle is pressing the issue on roof to get fixed especially in February during Tournament. Luis Ignacio has

removed the scissor lift and has been taken to another building. Patti Riddle wanted to thank Luis Ignacio and Latece Foster for doing a great job during closures and always communicating with them.

MUNI GYM/MORLEY FIELD: Center Director Oscar Eusebio reports that Municipal Gym had Toys for Tots, Breakfast with Santa. The gym was not closed for floor refinishing in December, and it will be postponed till February. Oscar Eusebio reports that at Morley Field, renovations were getting postponed but now have started with detaching or pulling the weeds, leveling the field, big project. North Park Little League partnered up with Diamond Designs to renovate the in-fields at the baseball fields. Oscar Eusebio reports that the youth basketball league has started and gives kudos to Muni gym staff for increasing the number of teams and kids.
