POLICY CORNER



Surveillance Camera Ordinance

On Tuesday, August 1, 2023, the City Council approved the Surveillance Camera Ordinance and the License Plate Readers technology as part of a single network to help the San Diego Police Department solve crimes. The City Council's Public Safety Committee, of which I am a member, recommended passage of the ordinance to the full Council.

Unsafe Encampment Ordinance

San Diego's Unsafe Camping Ordinance went into effect this week on Monday, July 31, 2023. The San Diego Police Department and outreach workers first educated sidewalk campers about the new law, homeless individuals are then given two warnings to go to a shelter or a safe camping/sleeping site when space is available. Homeless individuals will receive two warnings, the third

time will result in a citation. It is a slow process, but the goal is to provide a safe place for homeless individuals with the services they need to obtain permanent housing. The safe camping/sleeping sites can accommodate about 500 people. The sites are on city-owned parking lots on 20th and B Street and Parking Lot O.

Affordable Housing

More affordable housing is becoming available for San Diegans thanks to Mayor Todd Gloria’s Executive Order that directs the Development Services Department (DSD) to review and permit 100% affordable housing projects within 30 days. As a result, permitting of 628 affordable homes has been expedited with another 1,271 on the way. The DSD has launched the “Affordable Housing Permit Now” program to enhance services and provide a quick response.

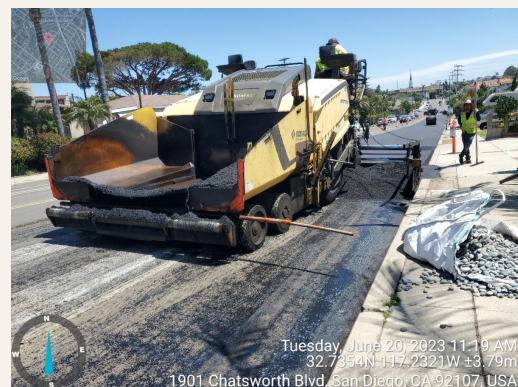
Safe Streets

My Council colleagues and I accepted grant funding from the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for traffic signal timing and upgrades in San Diego. The HSIP is a core Federal-aid program to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads, including non-State-owned and roads on tribal land. In San Diego, the grant funds will help improve up to 93 intersections in the beach areas, including in District 2.
