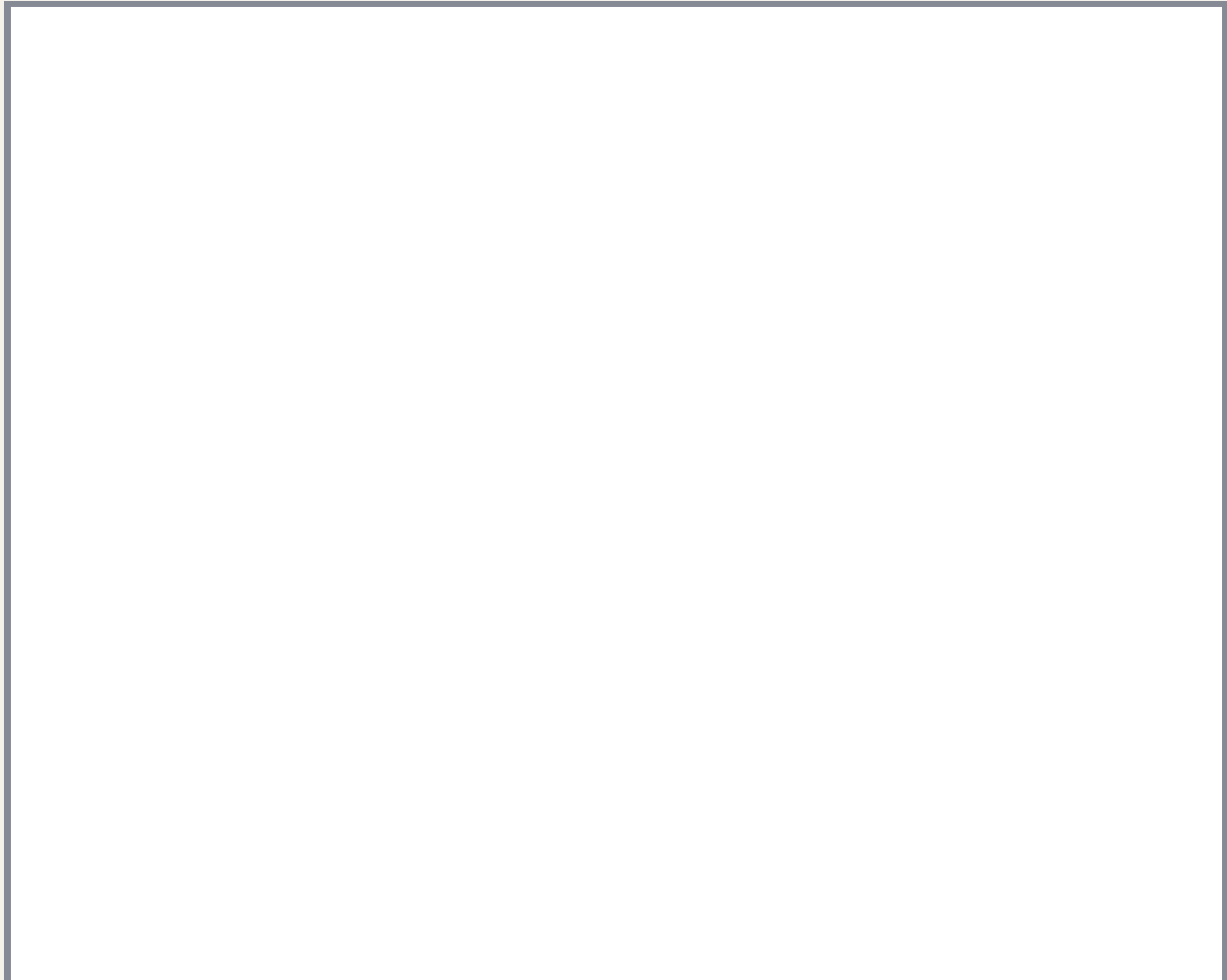

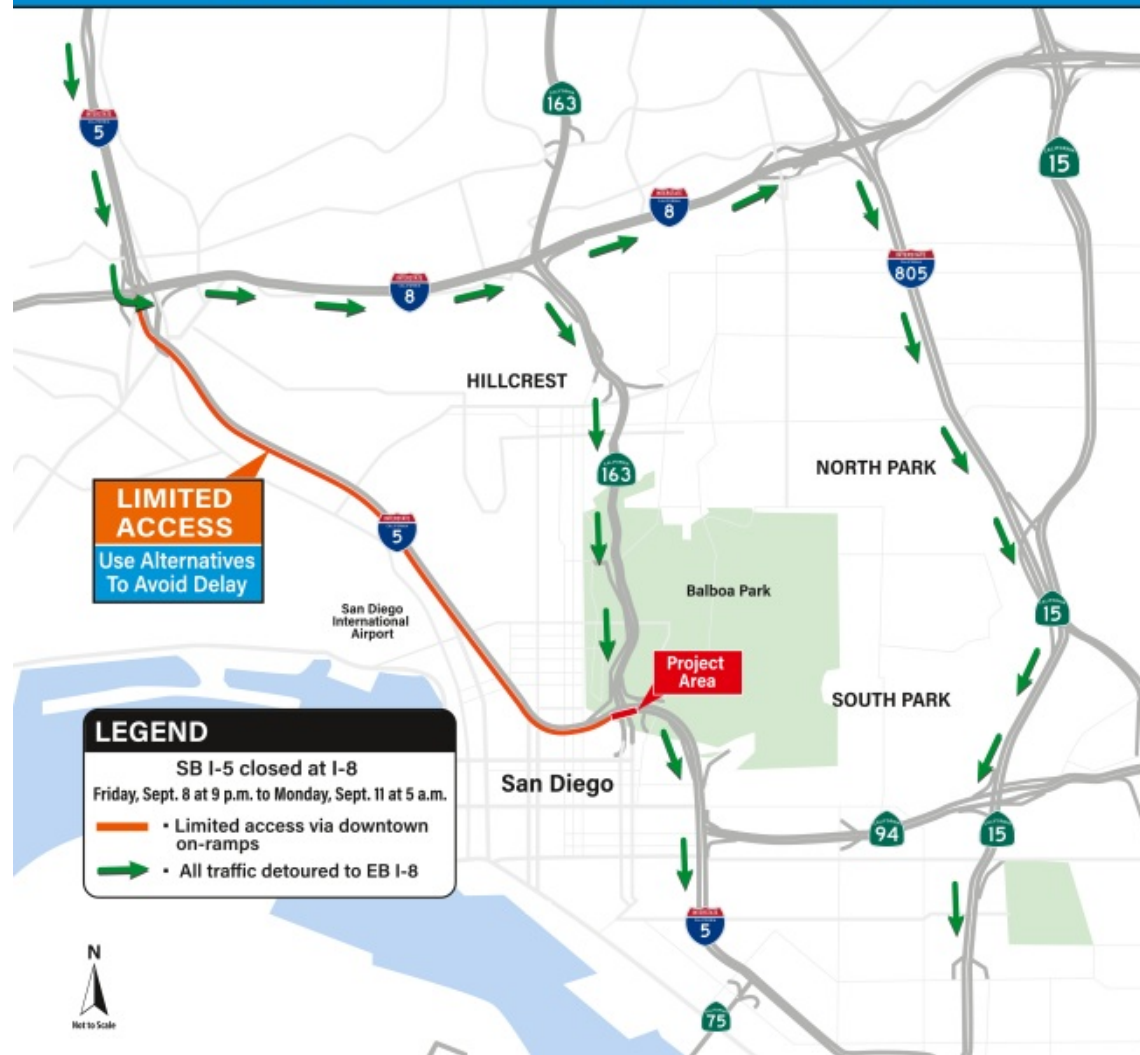

SB I-5 Closures for Bridge Repair



If you drive to Downtown this weekend, southbound I-5 at the I-8 will be closed, and there will be limited access via the downtown on-ramps. Caltrans crews will be repairing a bridge deck over State Route 163 and all traffic will be detoured to the I-8. The 56-hour closure will begin on **Friday, September 8 at 9 p.m. through Monday, September 11 at 5 a.m.** The bridge construction will affect traffic on SR-163, I-8, and I-5. 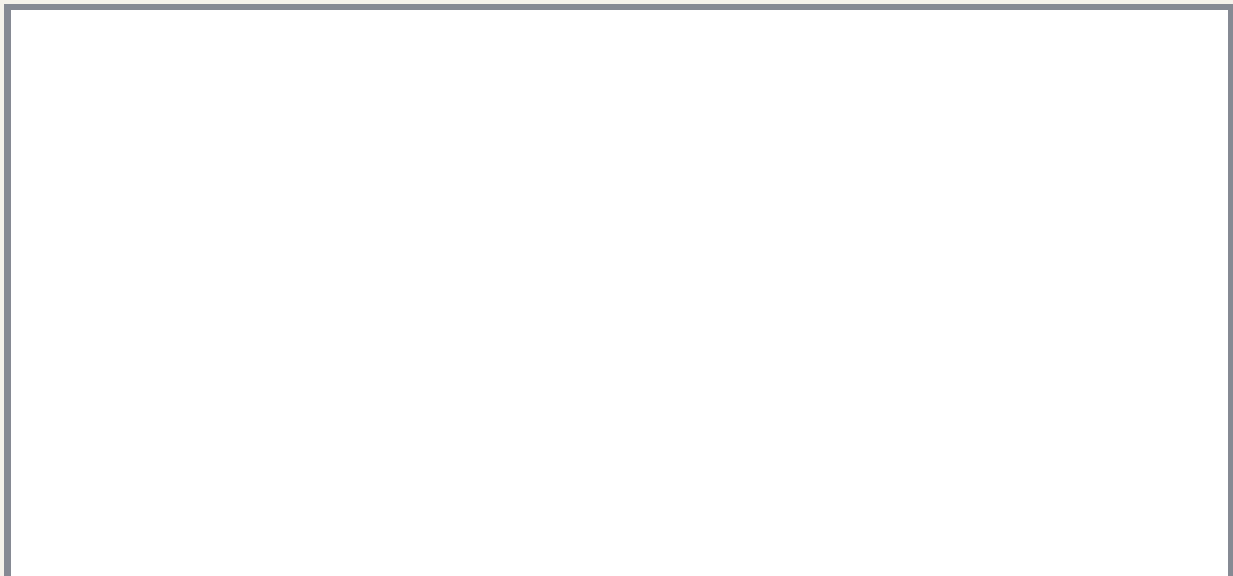
