### **SAFE PARKING LOT TO OPEN IN CLAIREMONT**

Safe Parking Lots are among the most successful of the City's homelessness solutions. The fourth one for our City will open soon and it is located next to the

Rose Canyon Yard on Morena Boulevard. SPLs are for homeless persons living in their vehicles and they provide security, meals, restrooms, showers, housing navigation, help with job searches, mental health, and addiction issues. The new SPL will operate 24/7 and it will provide trailers for homeless families as well as parking areas for people living in their vehicles.
