NEW STAFF

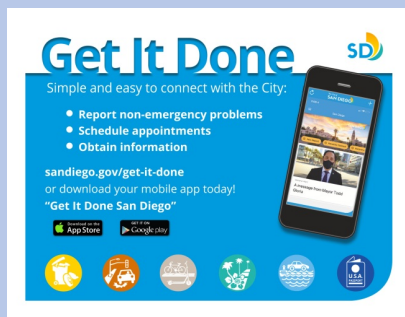
Help me welcome **Randy Reyes** to the Team Jen staff. Randy serves as Community Representative and he oversees constituent services for the Point Loma and Midway communities.
