Question:

Can the city attorney confirm what's said in this email from David Lundin? He cites a specific section of the city charter plus state laws that prohibit non-park use on park land. Also, would non-park uses be allowed temporarily as an emergency use? I believe that's been done before, such as when the military used some buildings in WWII.

Response:

Dedicated parkland has been used for non-park uses as recently as the Faulconer Administration, when a parking lot at 20th and B (which is within the Balboa Park footprint) was used as a temporary campground to protect unsheltered individuals during the Hepatitis A outbreak. Such temporary emergency uses are well established under the law.
