**“Instacart and San Diego City Attorney reach settlement in gig worker lawsuit”**

**Question:**

What is the status of the lawsuit against Uber and Lyft in San Francisco Superior Court? I see no actions in the case in the past 11 months. I see a motion to stay proceedings.

What is the status of the Prop 22 appeal before the Ninth Circuit? The last action I see was oral arguments in July 2022.

Does this settlement agreement mean that Instacart, moving forward, will now start classifying their workers as employees?

**Response:**

In the Uber/Lyft case, the trial court denied their arbitration motions last month and they're appealing.

The Castellanos case (the challenge to Prop. 22) is in the First District Court of Appeal at this time. The briefing is done and the next step is for the court to set oral argument.

Regarding your other question, the settlement requires them to classify their employees in a way that complies with Prop. 22, which is the law at the moment.
