PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS A NOTICE TO INFORM YOU, as a property owner, tenant or interested citizen, that the Council of The City of San Diego, California will conduct a public hearing, as part of a scheduled City Council meeting, on the following project:

An application for a Tentative Map to convert two existing two-story, 3,050-square-foot residential duplex buildings with four dwellings units into four condominium units, vacating a public sewer easement and waiving the requirement to underground existing offsite overhead utilities located at 1008-1014 South 44th Street. The 0.19-acre site is in the RM-2-5 Zone, San Diego Promise Zone, Airport Land Use Compatibility Zone and the Parking Standards Transit Priority Area within the Southeastern San Diego Community Plan Area.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15305 (Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations) and 15301 (Existing Facilities).

The final decision by the City of San Diego is not appealable to the California Coastal Commission. If you want to receive a Notice of Final Action, you must submit a written request to the City Project Manager listed above.

The decision of the City Council is final.

COMMUNICATIONS

If you wish to challenge the Council's actions on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence to the City Council at or prior to the public hearing.
