## FRIDAY- JUNE 16, 2017 TASK 5 FOCUS GROUPS: IMPLEMENTATION ISSUES

#### Background

The purpose of the Local Development Business Plan (LDBP) is to accelerate the deployment of local clean energy resources through Alameda County's Community Choice Energy program- East Bay Community Energy (EBCE). Task 5 of the LDBP is focused on identifying optimal approaches to implementation of the CCE program overall, and the LDBP itself. This includes recommendations regarding the streamlining of permitting (including CEQA and interconnection) of projects, getting local citizens involved, and recommendations for clear and transparent reporting (including GHG content of power portfolio).

#### **Goals of the Task 5 Focus Groups**

Robust community stakeholder engagement is an integral component of the LDBP project, and your input will help EBCE develop a feasible plan that maximizes local environmental, economic and social benefits. For Task 5 of the LDBP, it is important understand what has been proposed to and contemplated and/or implemented by existing and emerging Community Choice Energy programs, and what the implications of California's shifting legislative landscape and regulatory requirements are for EBCE's LDBP.
