**Bry Calls for Release of 101 Ash Street Report; Condemns City Attempts to Silence News Outlet**

**San Diego** — Councilwoman Barbara Bry today called for release of all reports and investigations into the 101 Ash Street scandal, including the report by the Burke Williams law firm, paid for by city taxpayers, that have not yet been released to the public. “The credibility of city administration has been legitimately called into question regarding the 101 Ash Street purchase. The public deserves to know the findings of all internal investigations into this transaction,” said Bry.

“I am particularly disturbed by reports that the City Attorney is attempting to silence a news outlet from reporting on this issue. Accountability means acknowledging mistakes, fully disclosing information regarding mistakes, and aggressively seeking to correct them, not attempting to cover them up, as the City Attorney’s recent actions suggest,” said Bry.
