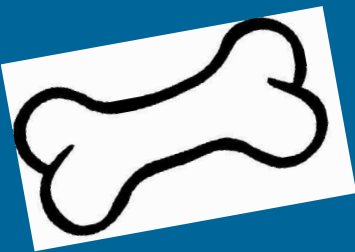
## National Night Out Pacific Beach and Clairemont
