San Diego – Councilmember Jennifer Campbell supports Mayor Todd Gloria's \$4.89 billion FY 2023 Budget. Under the new budget, District 2 constituents stand to gain significant funding to make changes in much-needed areas like Clairemont, Mission Beach, Clairemont, Ocean Beach, Point Loma, and Pacific Beach.

Councilmember Jennifer Campbell said: "I am happy to approve the Mayor's Budget along with my Council colleagues. Many of my budget requests were funded and will benefit District 2 residents.

District 2 Highlights:

- Increase City employees' salaries to attract and retain an excellent workforce.
- New staff positions created for outreach and education of the Street Vending and Short-Term Rental Ordinances. It is critical we focus on health and safety and access to public spaces for everyone.
- Increased funding for housing, shelter, and mental health services for people experiencing homelessness, including unhoused Seniors and LGBTQ+ youth.
- \$547,000 funding for the Homeless Conservatorship and Treatment Unit which will help those who are homeless and experiencing severe mental illness.
- Infrastructure, particularly roads like Ingraham Street, Clairemont Drive, and Morena Boulevard, sidewalks, and streetlights that are in desperate need of repair throughout the City, but especially in District 2."
