RE: Discontinuation of Gun Shows at Del Mar Fairgrounds

Honorable Board Members,

As Councilmembers of the City of San Diego, we are writing to urge you to discontinue the occurrence of gun shows at the Del Mar Fairgrounds. We share a firm belief that the State of California should neither help to promote nor help to facilitate the sale of firearms.

Data from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDCP) suggest there are 96 lives lost nationally to firearms each day. The CDC also estimates more than 200 people are injured daily by firearms. Gun-related devastation has found its way into our neighborhoods, movie theaters, concerts, and even our schools. Additionally, a plethora of academic studies confirm that the number of guns within a community correlates to higher rates of firearm homicide.

We recognize the right for citizens to keep and bear arms under the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America. However, in *District of Columbia v. Heller*, 554 U.S. 570 (2008), the United States Supreme Court ruled "the right to bear arms is *not unlimited*," and federal and state governments may enact reasonable regulations to protect public safety. As strong advocates of public safety, we believe it reasonably necessary to remove the State from involvement in activity that would increase the number of guns within our communities. Therefore, we strongly suggest the Board discontinue gun shows at the Del Mar Fairgrounds.
