Councilmember Gloria Comments on *Rebuild San Diego* Ballot Measure

SAN DIEGO, CA (March 8, 2016) – Councilmember Todd Gloria today released the following statement regarding the City Council's approval of placing the *Rebuild San Diego* measure on the June ballot.

"San Diegans are rightfully angry about the condition of our roads, sidewalks, and other public facilities," said Councilmember Gloria. **"Our crumbling neighborhood infrastructure is the single biggest issue facing our city and yet the *Rebuild San Diego* measure fails to solve this crisis.**

"Instead, this measure is just ballot box budgeting that ties the hands of decision makers for a generation. It will starve City services like our police, fire, library and park departments for funding while continuing to leave billions in unfunded infrastructure needs. Voters should oppose this measure and demand that the Mayor and City Council develop a real solution so San Diegans no longer have to drive over potholed streets and trip on cracked sidewalks."
