COUNCIL APPROVES A RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO HB 38 AND SB 446 REGARDING CONCEALED CARRY RECIPROCITY

SAN DIEGO, CA – San Diego Councilmember Chris Ward (District Three) issued the following statement after Council approval of a resolution in opposition to House of Representatives Bill 38 and Senate Bill 446 regarding Concealed Carry Reciprocity.

“Our action today shows we are committed to ensuring the communities we’re elected to represent are safe and that our values as San Diegans and Californians are heard. I was proud to support this resolution in committee and was happy to do so again today.

“This legislation intends to create a race to the bottom across the country for the state that can most quickly eliminate the rules that sustain safe gun ownership. After the loss of life at Sandy Hook, Pulse nightclub, and most recently Stoneman Douglas High School the last thing we should be considering is making it more difficult for our law enforcement to police guns in public, or making our gun laws weaker.”
